Discussion on the Sign Ordinance.

Kyle Jung, City Manager - currently the sign ordinance says certain ones are allowed for religious holidays and celebrations and that is the term that the City Attorney is having a difficult time defining. One of the things we can talk about is further identity or removal. Another option would be putting in a due process appeal over a denial, revocation, or interpretation of the sign ordinance. Third, there is another petition that is going to be coming forward concerning the sign ordinance. This is the Council's opportunity to discuss taking action on this.

Robert Gervais, City Attorney - Waving signs. In one case in particular regarding these, they ruled in the city's favor. It's a public safety/ distraction. Not to say some good points weren't raised against this. An appellate process is something we could discuss; this could help in cases where something is vague.

Jessica Rodriguez, Director of Development Services - asks Council about what they would like to see in regard to the attention-getting signs.

Council Member Albert - likes the idea of the appellate process.

Mayor Davison - the problem she has is "what's good for one is good for all". Is worried about what making big allowances because of issues with one business will do overall for the whole city.

Lorraine Hehn - the waving inflatable is not a big deal to her, but she can't find a group of people that want their city to look like another city where they allow all these kinds of signs. Can't find anyone that would want that.

Jason Albert - I would echo that. I don't want us to look like 1960, but I also would not like our hand to be forced with an ordinance that comes through via petition. So he thinks we need to come up with reasonable language that we can pinpoint and then add the appeals process, versus getting a haphazard voter initiative that comes together that inexperienced people don't see the effect. To me, it's a liability.

Mayor Davison - besides that, Willy is truly a distraction. It's in a school zone.

Ed Perry - my concern is that we don't set a precedent, or set a preference for one area. If that's really what the citizens want and they drive it to a vote, then that's what it is. That will be the consequence of it.

Kyle Jung - asking in advance of the agenda, does Council want staff to come up with any changes, or leave as is and move on?

Jason Albert - suggests that staff bring up what they think works to present to Council.

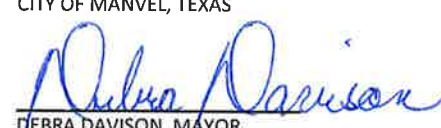
